Stocking Pattern

Stitch Out & Assembly

Materials:

Suggested fabrics:

Stitch Out - White Linen

Lining- light weight polyester lining, satin, sateen.

Backside & Hanger- velvet or decorative fabrics.

Stitchout Directions:

First determine if you want to stitch this out as one complete design or two separate designs.

Complete Stitch Out

To stitch out as one complete design you will use file numbers 9035 or 9036.

Hoop Required for complete Stitch Out:
186x300mm - 16 Count
174x277mm - 18 Count

Two File Stich Out

To stitch out in 2 stitchouts use file numbers 9028-9033

See PDF pages 10-11 for stitch out sizes

It is very important to use the same count on both stitchouts.

Stocking Pattern Stitchout & Assembly Directions (continued)

Directions to Stitch Out Stocking in 2 Separate Stitchouts

Print out stocking pattern then enlarge 148% on copier so that you can make sure you cut fabric enough for the pattern plus fabric on top for an embroidered name of your choice.

Stitch bottom of stocking first and hoop as shown in Illustration A. Stitch markers with a light color of your choice.

Top of Stocking

Bottom of Stocking Design

Stitch top of stocking next with the hoop in another position as Illustration B . Match markers by stitching the top markers on a scrap fabric or stabilizer. Take off hoop and the fold lines can help you re-hoop the stocking stitching. Then stitch the top markers without any thread and adjust to fit the bottom markers.

When both match, stitch colors as digitized.

Use the stocking pattern as a guide, it can be narrowed down as you desire.

Enlarge this print-out by 148% on a copier to get correct stocking size.
Copy must be on 11" x 17" paper.

Suggested fabrics:

Lining- light weight polyester lining, satin, sateen.

Backside & Hanger- velvet or decorative fabrics.

Sewing Instructions

1. Enlarge this page 148% and cut hanger and lining.
2. Cut front and back side with right sides together. Center stitched design before cutting.
3. Iron on interfacing to both sides of outer fabric.
4. Stitch lining right side together with 3/8" seam allowance.
5. Stitch front and back together with 3/8" seam allowance. Turn inside out.
6. Fold hanger in half. Stitch. Turn inside out. Attach to top edge of stocking.
7. Place stitched lining inside, wrong sides together. Fold down 3/8". Press. Top stitch.
